September's Speakers



Life-Long learning Right Here in Bracebridge!

Prior to hearing our main speaker last month, Probus SM member Rena Liebster and Nippissing Campus Administrator Jan Lucy introduced us to the innovative new program for life-long learners which will be offered this fall to anyone 50 years of age or older looking for an intellectual challenge and a chance to collaborate with other learners from the region. This non-credit progam will allow life-long learners to blend into existing university courses with other degree-bound students without the burden of submitting assignments or taking exams. Following the success of two prior courses on *Dirt* and *Sloth*, this year's offering, overseen by award winning Nipissing University Professor Renee Valiquette will focus on an interdisciplinary analysis of Water.



Our main speaker **Tony Sutey**, Senior Financial Advisor and the Huntsville Branch Manager for Assante Capital proposed several ideas and strategies for retirees to protect and grow their wealth because wealth can

only be generated by the accumulation and careful management of the money you have. First you must guard against permanent loss by recognizing and avoiding fraudulent scenarios and get rich quick schemes or tell tale signs like corporate executives selling their shares and closing out their options. He advocates a trusted advisor as one of the best lines of defense as he or she can steer you towards the right investments and help you make logical decisions and enhance the performance of your portfolio.

The same advisor can help you with life insurance to preserve the value of your estate by providing enough cash to offset possible death duties. As a tax advisor/preparer, he can also help you reduce your current income taxes by claiming credits for such things as accumulated medical expenses and the disability tax credit which have expanded eligibility requirements in the past few years and now allow for the transfer of the credit to the parent or individual with the higher income. New pension splitting rules can reduce the amount clawed back from a couples' Old Age Security income. An experienced financial advisor can help you decide when and if to withdraw and repay amounts from your RRSP before age 71 to minimize your income tax payable.

One final pointer: since its introduction in 2009, the TFSA has provided a tax free vehicle for individuals to preserve and generate capital. We now all have \$31,000 contribution room so if you haven't done so already, get saving!

In short a good financial advisor should be able to grow wealth by protecting against losses and volatility through the careful allocation of our assets so we can keep up with rising costs.
